Minimum Stay. All accommodations require a two-night minimum stay with one night deposit to secure reservations.

Check In. Check-ins are generally at 3pm, but if we have a back-to-back reservations, we ask that you check in at 4pm. Please advise what time you plan on arriving so we can provide adequate information to late arrivals and first-time guests.

Contact Information. Cabin use reservations are through info@kokee.org. Group stays or barracks use is negotiated directly with the camp manager, cccamp@kokee.org.

Payment. All payments must be made in full at least 14 days prior to your stay. You may pay by credit card by calling our office staff at 808-335-9975. A check can be made out to Hui o Laka and mailed to P.O. Box 100, Kekaha, HI 96752.

Cancellations. There are no fees charged for cancellations, except for the week prior to your stay. Any cancellations 7 days prior to and up to the day before your reservation with notification, forfeit \$75. Any returns of deposits will be made by check, postmarked within 7 days of notification. No refunds will be offered for no shows.

Cabins

Mokihana Cabin \$200 per night (sleeps 6 in one great room with two queen beds and two single beds.) The cabin has a small kitchen with an electric range and refrigeration with a separate bathroom. There is a dining room table and bar counter. The cabin features a deep porch with picnic table.

Orchard Cabin \$160 per night (sleeps 4 in two bedrooms with one double bed in one, and two singles in the other.) The cabin had a small kitchen with a gas stove and electric refrigerator with a separate bathroom. There is no living room. There is a porch to hang out on and outdoor picnic table.

Parking. A single, double stall is available for parking two cars.

Barracks

We are slowly opening the full camp with new requirements. If you have used the camp before, please review the following and Camp Use - Fine Print as many things have changed.

Barracks use is primarily for group accommodations. Minimum stay is two nights. Deposits and sanitation fees will be applied to rates. Turnaround times on their use can be several days and need the permission of the camp manager. Individual use may be available but not far in advance. If you want a particular date, please consider one of our cabins that is better suited to individual and family stays. Only registered guests are allowed at the camp. The camp, due to parking and delicate historic structures, is not available for parties and gatherings with outside guests.

Currently groups are limited to 15 people. Although the CCC Camp can handle up to 46 people maximum capacity in the barracks and 56 people if the entire camp is used, the rates below do not include the Mess Hall. For example, Barracks B, with its typical bunkhouse layout, needs to have use of the Mess Hall. If you are looking for housing more than these numbers, please be advised to look elsewhere. Tent camping or nonguest use of the premises mixed with onsite users are not allowed. The parking situation is too limited. Abuse of the facility has been an ongoing problem in the past. It is a special historic place and deserves proper respect.

All restrictions in "Camp Use - The Fine Print" are applicable. If you have larger groups than our maximum numbers, look elsewhere for accommodations or plan to downsize your activity.

Barrack B. This is a typical bunk house-type accommodations for group use only, with two multi-user bathrooms. It can be used to separate mixed groups and has adequate showers and toilets. Barrack B accommodations don't include a kitchen with cooking facilities. The Mess Hall requires a separate fee and is not exclusive. There may be additional requirements, fees, and deposits. These are just the accommodation fees.

Barrack B one side (from 1 to 15 persons) \$450 per night Barrack B both sides (from 1 to 30 persons) \$900 per night

Barracks C. Individual units can be rented by separate parties with a shared, single bathroom, and a common area with a microwave and Keurig coffee maker. Use of the Mess Hall requires a separate fee and not exclusive. There may be additional requirements, fees, and deposits. These are just the accommodation fees.

Barrack C - Dreamers Semiprivate Room (1-2 persons) \$75 per night

Barrack C - Dreamers Bunkroom (from 1 to 10 persons) \$300 per night

Parking. Only three parking stalls are available at the camp for barracks use. Plan on car or van pooling.

Covid. Larger groups involve greater risk for contracting and spreading diseases such as Covid. We also suggest health screening of individuals prior to camp arrival for the safety of your group and others you involve in your activities. Any sick individuals are not welcome. If anyone is sick, they need to wear a mask indoors. Any group/organization protocols regarding Covid or other illnesses during your stay will be part of the discussion.

Everything must be clean and returned to its original location. We do not supply charcoal or firewood. Other restrictions apply.
